During their studies, in addition to theoretical concepts, they will acquire practical skills in the various aspects of business including information technology. An important area will be the enhancement of skills related to the selling and buying of organizational products and services via the global electronic system.

Enrolment to the Bachelor of Business Administration (Hons.) in E-Commerce programme is now ongoing for the March 2017 session. Students who meet any of the following requirements are eligible to enter the business degree programme: A-Level with 2 passes/STPM with minimum Grade C (CGPA 2.0) in any 2 subjects/5 Bs in UEC/Completed an accredited Foundation in Business programme (minimum CGPA 2.0). Those having a diploma which has been accorded minimum standard by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) are eligible to transfer up to a maximum of 36 credit hours to the degree programme.
